


Beyond the Door Stage Play

Author Bio

Denise's story is a powerful testament to resilience and transformation. From a challenging start in life, she has overcome significant adversity to become a source of inspiration for many. Denise was born in Chicago, Illinois in the early 60s. Her childhood was rough, having been a victim of incest and molested at the age of five by relatives *and* family friends. At the age of twelve, her mother introduced her to a lifestyle that kept her longer than she wanted to be kept. She was also introduced to homosexuality by a woman seven years older. Introduced to heroin by her mother, she became addicted and began committing crimes to support the habit. This lasted for over 15 years.

Denise eventually obtained her GED, bachelor's, and master's degrees, and is the author of "Who Said It Couldn't Be Done" published in English and Spanish. Her book, "Who Said It Couldn't Be Done?", is a candid chronicle of her journey through life's hardships, including poverty, addiction, and incarceration, to finding sobriety, spiritual redemption, and inner peace. Denise's message of hope and renewal has reached a wide audience, not only through her writing but also through her

As the owner of Diamond 7 Enterprises LLC,
Denise has focused on providing employment
opportunities for the formerly incarcerated,
helping them reintegrate into society and find
a new path forward. As an evangelist and
motivational speaker, sharing her story further
amplifies her mission to help others break free
from their internal prisons. She was ordained an
evangelist in 2016, is an inspirational and
motivational speaker, and has been on a passionate
mission to share with others how to break free from the

prison within.

The stageplay "Beyond the Door," adapted from her book "A Diamond from the Rough," has resonated with audiences, leading to sold-out shows and a demand for its return. Denise's ongoing projects, including her second book "The Prison In Me, Break Free," continue to spread her message of hope and the possibility of a new beginning. It's inspiring to see how Denise has channeled her experiences into positive actions that benefit others, showing that change and redemption are possible, no matter one's past.
